Types of Expenses

愈	Housing and Utilities	Rent, mortgage, insurance, property taxes, electricity, gas, water, sewage, television, Internet service
69	Phone	Landline or cellphone payments
盦	Debt and Court Payments	Credit card payments, restitution, student loan payments, payday loan payments, pawn loan payments, other loan payments
***	Transportation	Gas, car payment, insurance payment, repair, public transport fees, parking fees
$\hat{\Phi}$	Healthcare	Co-payments, medication, eye care, dental care, health insurance premiums
Ť	Childcare	Childcare costs, diapers, school supplies, school materials fees, field trip and other activity fees
	Groceries	Food, beverages, or ingredients to be brought into the home, including baby formula
X	Eating Out	Any meals/beverages purchased outside of the home, including fast food, coffee, energy drinks, or other one-time food/drink purchases
	Household Supplies	Things for your home like cleaning supplies, tools, kitchen appliances, furniture, or other equipment
jiji	Personal Care	Haircuts, hygiene items, cosmetics, clothes, dry cleaning
Ŵ	Entertainment	Movies, concerts, sports/equipment fees, sporting events, lottery tickets, memberships, books/CDs, subscriptions
	Job-Related Expenses	Union dues, job-related tools, equipment, clothing, books, machinery, working animals or livestock
*	Pets	Pet supplies, food, healthcare costs
	Gifts and Donations	Gifts to friends/families, donations to charities or religious organizations
6	Savings	Saving for emergencies, goals, back to school expenses, holiday purchases, children's education, saving for retirement
	Other	Any expenses that don't fall into the above categories
