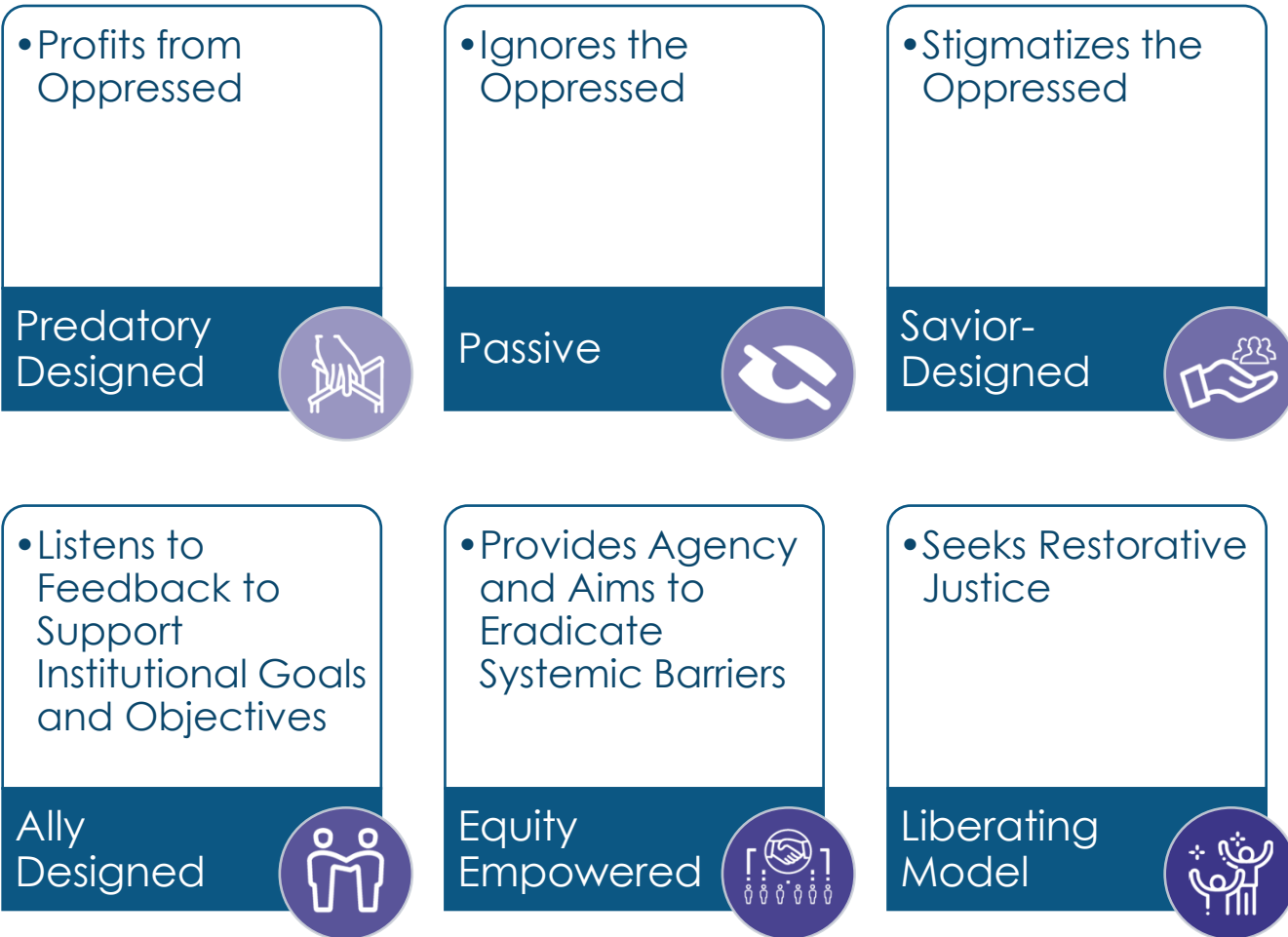

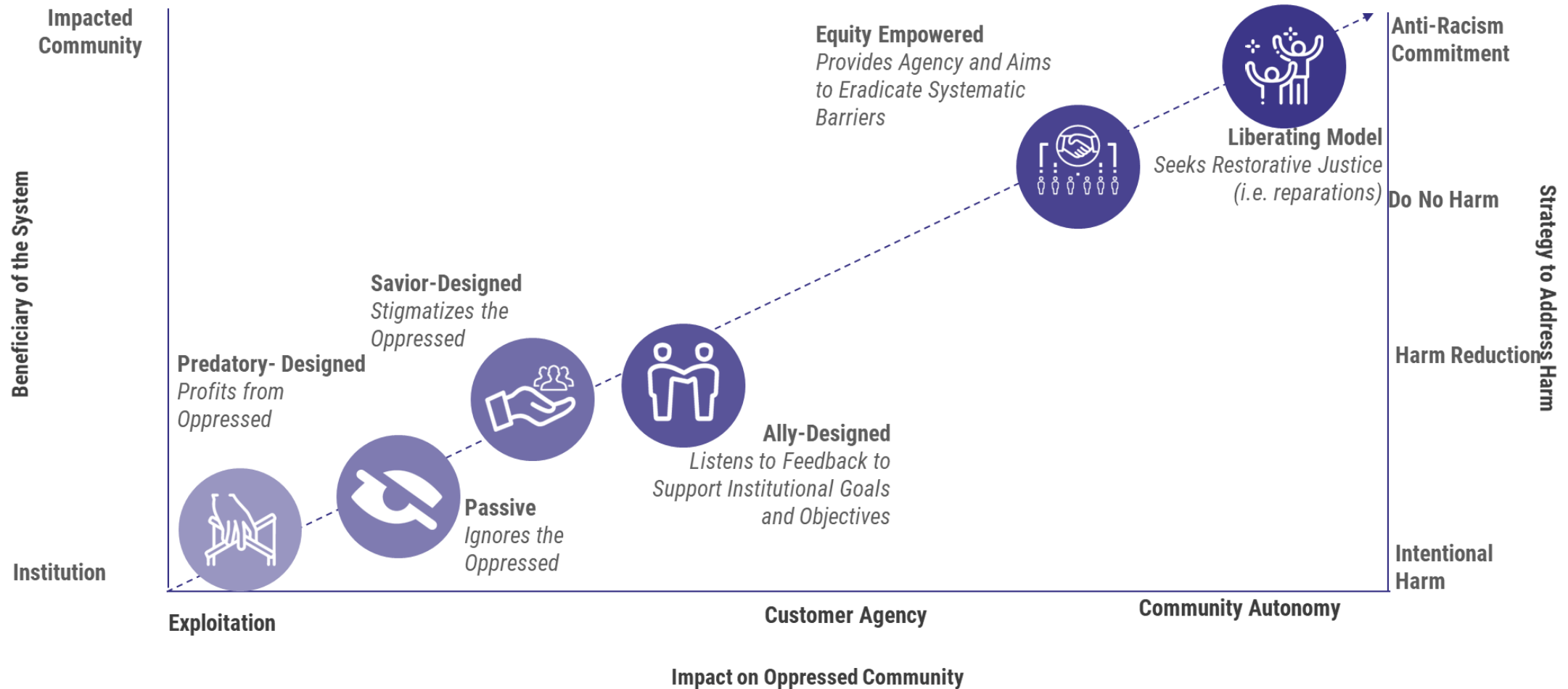

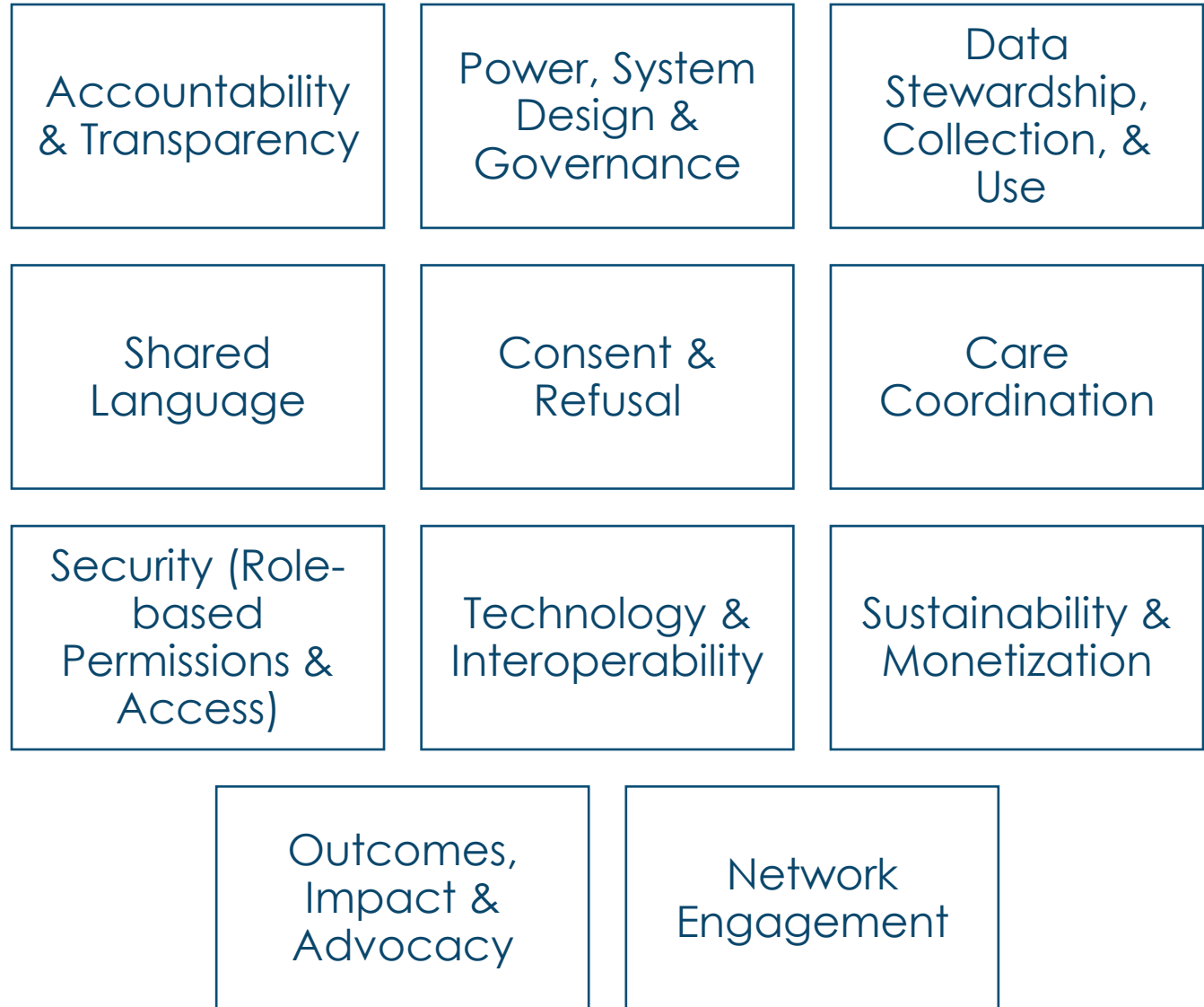

# Drivers & Definitions

## Informed Consent & Refusal

- Process in which someone's information is shared with others, and ability/inability to stop the use or sharing of information

## Power, System Design & Governance

- Core stewardship and decision-making of a CIE, including voices that are represented and influence on the system. Define purpose, mission and value proposition.

## Data Stewardship, Collection, & Use

- Who stewards and the rights to the collection and use of personal data, and is in position to provide analysis

## Accountability & Transparency

- Responsibility/Role in which information is gathered, used and shared to make change or influence decisions for individual, across organizations and with the larger community.

## Security (Role-based Permissions & Access)

- The protection and partitions in place that delineate who sees specific types of information and how information is accessed

## Technology & Interoperability

- Tool used to share information and its ability to integrate and exchange responsibly and ethically with other systems.

## Sustainability & Monetization

- Process in which the initial investment, cost-savings, ongoing benefit/profit and re-investment

## Shared Language

- Collective definition of comprehensive health and social needs through standards and best practices across systems of care, which could include the individual/family, and infrastructure to support the communication.

## Outcomes, Impact & Advocacy

- Significance of the impact on the population, how it is measured, who defines the measurements and how they are shared.

## Care Coordination

- System can organize and support participation across organizations and with the Individual/family.

## Network Engagement

- Role in which participating organizations and institutions are bought in, ready, engaged on infrastructure, quality improvement, workflows and learning.
