#### **MERCY HOUSING MILLWORKS**

Mercy Housing Northwest is excited to be opening a new family affordable housing property at the Bellingham downtown waterfront in spring of 2024. Millworks is an 83 unit property that includes 1, 2, and 3 bedroom units with rents set based on 50% or 60% of area median income. Onsite resident services will be available, as well as a 6 classroom early learning center operated by the YMCA.

Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis starting January 22, 2024. Applications can be submitted <u>online</u>, in-person at Mercy's Evergreen Ridge temporary leasing office at 3451 Woburn St., or by phone at (360) 788-5152, TTY (800) 877-8973.
