The IRS has announced the 2021 tax filing season will begin February 12th. This year, local organizations are preparing to provide nocontact and virtual tax preparation services at no cost to Whatcom County residents who make up to \$66,000 per year. IRS certified preparers will be available to assist at Northwest Indian College, Western Washington University, and online through United Way. Additionally, anyone whose AGI was \$72,000 or less in 2020 can file their own taxes for free online through the IRS Free File Program. Help your clients avoid costly fees and predatory commercial preparers by encouraging them to utilize a free IRS certified program this year.
