Promoting the Earned Income Tax Credit

One in five eligible tax payers miss out on claiming the <u>Earned</u> <u>Income Tax Credit</u> each year. Join us in promoting <u>EITC Awareness</u> this year to help ensure Whatcom County community members know how to claim this important tax credit worth up to \$6,935.

EITC eligibility depends on several factors, including income and family size, but it's easy to find out if you qualify. Use the <u>EITC</u> <u>Assistant</u> to verify eligibility and estimate the amount of your credit.
