MID-CERTIFICATION REVIEWS WAIVED

DSHS has <u>temporarily waived Mid-Certification Reviews</u> for food and cash programs. Cash and/or food benefit recipients with a six-month review due in January, February or March 2022 will <u>not</u> have to complete their Mid-Certification Review at this time. Annual Eligibility Reviews are still required, so it is important to pay attention to letters and forms sent by DSHS, or visit <u>washingtonconnection.org</u> to check for any upcoming due dates. As DSHS has been experiencing longer than usual phone wait times, this temporary waiver will help to reduce hold times and improve customer experience.

OTHER TIPS TO AVOID LONG WAIT TIMES:

Try online: visit <u>washingtonconnection.org</u> for many services. Know when to call: avoid calling on Mondays, and the first & last weeks of the month, and call before 11am when possible. Use the automated phone system: service available 24/7. Apply through Opportunity Council: to apply for food benefits, call 360-734-5121 option 3.



DISASTER RECOVERY CENTER

Now open in Whatcom County

FEMA, in partnership with the Washington State Military Department's Emergency Management Division, has opened a <u>Disaster Recovery Center</u> in <u>Whatcom County</u> to help survivors of the November flooding and mudslides. Recovery specialists are available to help residents of Clallam, Skagit and Whatcom counties, including the Lummi Nation, Nooksack Indian Tribe, the Quileute Nation and other tribes in the three counties, apply for federal assistance and receive information about help available for homeowners, renters and business owners. The center is located at 1208 East Main St. in Everson, and is open 9am - 8pm Mon. - Sat., and 12 - 6pm Sun.
