EMERGENCY & SEVERE WEATHER SHELTERS

There are a variety of shelter options available for community members who are experiencing homelessness this winter. For the most up to date shelter information, call the emergency shelter hotline at 360-788-7983. This hotline is updated as shelter resources become available. Shelter options include:

Shelter options include:

- <u>Base Camp</u>: overnight shelter and day center for adults (18+).
- <u>Young Adult Winter Shelter:</u> overnight shelter for young adults ages 18 -24 (up to age 29 if forecast is below 32 degrees, or snow is in the forecast). Located at Civic Field.
- The PAD: emergency housing for minors ages 13 17.
- Ferndale Severe Weather Shelter: overnight shelter for individuals and families. Only open in severe weather events.

FEMA FLOOD RELIEF

Now available for many Whatcom residents

The flooding event Whatcom County experienced in November has officially been declared a federal disaster, meaning impacted households may be eligible for FEMA financial assistance. To request assistance, apply <u>online</u> or by phone: 1-800-621-3362.

To apply, the following information will be needed:

- Social Security Number (OR the SSN of a minor child in the household)
- Annual Household Income
- Contact Information
- Insurance Information (if insured)
- Bank Account Information (if eligible, financial assistance can be direct deposited into an account)
