

EVICTION RESOLUTION PILOT PROGRAM

In coordination with Whatcom County Superior Court, the Whatcom Dispute Resolution Center has officially launched a new eviction prevention program, requiring tenants and landlords in Whatcom County to try to resolve issues around rent owed through an eviction resolution specialist or mediation, before eviction cases may be filed in court.

Now operational in Whatcom County, the Eviction Resolution Pilot Program (ERPP) aims to stabilize housing and reduce a pending wave of eviction cases once Bridge Proclamation 21-09 expires on Oct. 31. Read more on the background and development of this program in the press release here.
