LOW-INTENSITY RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT

Lifeline Connections in partnership with the Opportunity Council will be opening a <u>Men's Low-Intensity Residential Program</u> in late October. This new substance use and mental health treatment facility will provide a safe, stable home for up to 16 individuals while they receive the tools necessary to begin their transition back into the community. Training for jobseekers age 50+

Washington AARP is offering a new "Skills for the Digital Economy" initiative for jobseekers age 50+. This free program provides individualized coaching, training, support, and resources to help jobseekers succeed in finding work. Participants will receive career guidance, job search tools, computer and technical skills training, and more. Interested jobseekers can sign up by <u>registering for an orientation</u>. After orientation and a series of assessments, participants will be assigned to one of four pathways: Short-term Training, Rapid Reemployment, Intensive Technical Training, or Self-Employment & Entrepreneurship.
