APPLICATIONS DUE FOR FREE 6-RIDE TICKETS FROM WTA

Whatcom Transportation Authority (WTA) invites Social and Health Services Agencies to apply for free 6-ride tickets for distribution to their clients throughout 2024. WTA will provide up to 50,000 sets of free 6-ride tickets to approved agencies.

Organizations seeking free 6-ride tickets—including those who participated in the program in the past—will need to submit an application. ACCESS ID CLINIC TIMES EXPANDING

Wednesdays at Opportunity Council starting in December

Access ID Clinics will now be offered at 1111 Cornwall Ave, Bellingham, every Wednesday from 9-11:30 starting in December. See [flyer](#) for dates and times this month. Participants must be residents of Whatcom County and 200% below the federal poverty limit.

Clinic consults range from 10-15 minutes, and participants should bring any existing documents relating to their identity if possible, including documents showing a name, date of birth, or photo. The program can cover the costs and fees associated with getting a Washington ID or Enhanced ID card. Free interpreting and ASL services are available.
