

SEVERE WEATHER SHELTERS

The Whatcom County Health Department and City of Bellingham have partnered with Road2Home to offer additional overnight shelter and daytime warming options when weather is severe enough to threaten health and safety. These temporary facilities will be activated when forecasts predict specific and dangerous temperature and precipitation conditions.

FRAUD ALERT

EBT Skimming on the Rise



EBT fraud reports have increased across the state and country. The fraud is aimed at getting EBT card information and PIN numbers through card skimming. Skimming involves the use of electronic equipment to capture a customer's card number and PIN information to create a counterfeit or duplicate card. If you believe you are a victim of EBT card fraud, call 888-328-9271 to report the card as stolen. You can deactivate the card at this number, and a new card can be sent to you. Clients are also encouraged to file a report with their local police department.
