- To pick up EBT cards, authorized bus passes & gas cards, preauthorized WorkFirst support service vouchers, ABD application documents that cannot be mailed, and verification documents for reduced-price ID.
- Customers who do not have access to a phone and/or computer may use the lobby phones and/or computers to connect with DSHS services.
