WHATCOM COUNTY WINTER SHELTERS 2025-2026

Health and Community Services will operate a severe weather shelter at 925 N. Forest Street in Bellingham. This shelter provides adults (18+) a safe and warm place to sleep. Staff will monitor the forecasted temperature and consult opening criteria to determine activation. We will announce opening information at least 48 hours in advance, when possible.

Ferndale Community Services will operate a severe weather shelter for Ferndale and North Whatcom County residents. The shelter is located at the <u>United Church of Ferndale (2034 Washington St)</u> and provides individuals and families a safe and warm place to sleep.
