#### **NOVEMBER CRN MEETING NOTES**

At this month's CRN Meeting we heard from the Bellingham Food Bank. They shared a bit about who they are, the trends they see, people they work with, and ways to connect and collaborate with the food bank. Whatcom County has seen a 127% increase in food bank visits since 2021, and the Bellingham Food Bank is adapting to these changes to help keep our community fed.

We also had the opportunity to hear important updates and announcements from those who attended, including Northwest Justice Project, World Relief, Opportunity Council, Fountain Community Church, Northwest Regional Council, Health Ministries Network, and Lifelong.

### STATE OPENS HEALTHCARE MARKETPLACE TO UNDOCUMENTED RESIDENTS

Washington is the first state in the nation to do so

This month, Washington became the first state to open its insurance marketplace to all residents, including all undocumented immigrants. State health insurance exchanges explicitly exclude undocumented immigrants. To change that, states have to get a special waiver from the federal government, and Washington is the first state to get that waiver
