FERNDALE SEVERE WEATHER SHELTER

The <u>Ferndale Community Service Cooperative</u> is operating a Severe Weather Shelter Pilot Program this winter. The temporary shelter will provide a safe, warm place to sleep for individuals and families in the Ferndale area who have nowhere else to stay when severe weather conditions exist. The shelter will be open when the temperature drops to 28 degrees or lower, or 32 degrees if there is a high wind warning or 1 inch of precipitation on the ground/expected. The shelter may open in some other severe weather events, such as flooding. When open, shelter hours are 5pm-8am, and doors typically close at 8pm. The shelter is currently located at Christ Lutheran Church in Ferndale (location subject to change). Call or text "help" to 360-612-5075 for updated information, including openings, hours, and location.
