

Peer supporters offer a safe space to share mental health recovery experiences with someone trained to listen. The goal is to learn together, strategizing to move towards hope and possibility.

Services are intended to be a short term peer support offering with the goal of building a larger support network and toolkit outside of the peer relationship.

NAMI programs are not intended to replace the specialized training and professional judgment of mental health professionals.

Know your rights when navigating housing systems

Northwest Justice Project has created a new guide for renters: <u>How to request a disability accommodation as a tenant.</u> Use this guide to learn if and how you can request changes to your housing to accommodate a disability, and what to do if a landlord won't make reasonable changes. It includes a sample letter that tenants can send to their landlord to ask for an accommodation. The guide is also available in <u>Spanish</u>.
