SNAP EMERGENCY ALLOTMENTS EXTENDED

Great news for Washington SNAP recipients! There is now a declaration in place that allows DSHS to apply for emergency allotments past the end of the state emergency. Though we anticipated these additional food benefits would come to an end in November, due to this new declaration, DSHS has received approval to provide extra food benefits up to the maximum allotment for December 2022. DSHS will continue to request federal emergency allotments on a month-by-month basis as long as the federal public health emergency is in place.

SEVERE WEATHER SHELTER

Overnight and Day Warming Sites Available

Whatcom County residents have a few options for emergency shelter and daytime warming this winter when weather is severe:

- Base Camp is always open with increased overflow capacity
- <u>Bellingham Severe Weather Shelter</u> has capacity for 40 guests at Civic Field when criteria to open the shelter are met
- <u>Ferndale Severe Weather Shelter</u> is available to individuals and families when criteria to open the shelter are met
- <u>Bellingham day-use warming center</u> at Bellingham Public Library Central Branch is available when criteria to open the center are met
