# **RENTAL ASSISTANCE**

As part of the second federal economic relief package, nearly \$6 million will be available to help Whatcom residents with rent and utility assistance. Assistance will be available at the Opportunity Council beginning in March. Landlords or tenants can call 360-746-3826 anytime to hear up-to-date Whatcom County rental assistance information in both English and Spanish. Beginning Monday, March 1 at 8am, tenants or landlords can leave a message on this line to receive a call back for an eligibility screening. As there are a limited number of appointments, screening will occur in the order that voicemails are received. More appointments will be available in subsequent months through the end of the year or until all funds have been distributed. People who apply for this assistance are encouraged to be prepared with household income in order to confirm eligibility. While either landlord or tenant can apply for this assistance, we strongly encourage tenants to apply when possible in order to expedite the process. Landlords applying on behalf of their tenants will be required

to leave one voicemail per tenant or household seeking assistance. Read more here, and feel free to share this flyer with information in English, Spanish, and Russian.
