WHAT MAKES UP A CREDIT SCORE?

A Credit Score is a measure of how likely you are to repay a loan on time. Currently, the most commonly used score model is the FICO 8, and while the exact algorithmic formula is proprietary, the general formula for this and most other scores looks like:

- 35% Payment History
- 30% Credit Utilization
- 15% Credit History
- 10% New Credit
- 10% Mix of loans
