FREE VETERINARY WELLNESS CLINIC

Animal Emergency Care will be providing basic wellness care for dogs and cats belonging to houseless members of our community. Both dogs and cats will receive an examination, food, parasite control (while supplies last), and the following vaccinations:

IS YOUR INFO UP TO DATE?



Now that emergency food benefits allotments have ended, it is a great time for Basic Food/SNAP recipients to make sure their household information is up to date. Some households may have put off reporting changes while the extra emergency benefits were in place, meaning their new benefit amount might not be accurate. Changes like a decrease in income, increase in housing costs, or addition of household members could lead to a higher benefit amount.
