

DISASTER LEGAL SERVICE

A <u>legal hotline</u> is now available for survivors of the severe storms, flooding, landslides, and mudslides in Clallam, Skagit, and Whatcom Counties and the Lummi Nation, Nooksack Indian Tribe, and Quileute Tribe. Disaster survivors facing legal issues related to the severe storms, flooding, landslides, and mudslides may call the hotline at 509-557- 0301 to receive limited legal assistance from a volunteer lawyer.
