

SENIOR FARMERS MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM

Application available online & at Senior Centers

The Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) provides lower income seniors with an electronic benefits card that can be used to purchase \$80 in fresh fruits, vegetables, honey, and fresh-cut herbs at approved farmers markets and farm stores. To qualify, you must be age 60+ (or 55+ if Native American/Alaska Native) and meet income requirements. Learn more about this benefit here">here.
