In March 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act was signed into law and provided funding for the Pandemic Emergency Assistance Fund. PEAF is a one-time, non-recurrent cash payment for low-income families with eligible children, and will be issued in May 2022. The PEAF benefit amount will be \$127 per eligible child. In order to qualify for PEAF, families must meet the following criteria:

- Have a minor child in the home who received cash or basic food benefits for the month of May 2022
- Have income at or under 75% of the Federal Poverty Level

Families do not need to apply for this benefit; the cash payment will automatically be issued if their household is eligible. Qualifying households will receive a letter with more information.

### **ASK A DOCTOR WEBINARS**
