CAMPUS BASIC NEEDS RESOURCES

Over half of students enrolled in public colleges and universities in Washington state experienced <u>basic</u> <u>needs insecurity in 2024.</u> For students attending <u>Whatcom Community College</u>, <u>Bellingham Technical College</u>, and <u>Western Washington University</u>, basic needs offices provide a hub of support for things like housing, transportation, and food. All three campuses offer a food pantry and are able to assist with food benefit applications. Basic needs navigators can help students find and utilize resources, make plans around finances, and cultivate community belonging.

Program helps family members raising children

Kinship is the raising of children by grandparents, extended family members, or adults with whom they have a family-like relationship. <u>Kinship Navigation Services</u> and Kinship Caregiver Support Programs are available.
