The numbers are in, and they're headed in the wrong direction. According to new statistics, WA consumers lost nearly \$69 million to fraud in 2020, more than double the amount lost in 2019. It seems the scammers may be gaining the upper hand in the fight for our hard-earned dollars. Con-artists are becoming ever more sophisticated in their tactics, and new scams are emerging at an increasing pace. Even the most informed consumer can find themselves struggling to keep up.
