EVICTION MORATORIUM EXTENSION

With both state and national moratoriums on evictions set to expire June 30, Washington renters received good news this week:

- The CDC moratorium has been extended through July 31
- Gov. Inslee has announced a "bridge" proclamation effective July 1 through September 30. Under the new order, new provisions will support renters and landlords until resources and programs become available. Read more [here](#).

Though tenants are temporarily protected from evictions for non-payment, [Rental Assistance](#) is available to help renters catch up on past-due rent. Whatcom tenants and landlords can apply [online](#) or by phone the first business day of each month at 8am.

Opportunity Council to resume WTA PASS DISTRIBUTION

In light of WTA resuming fare collection on July 1, Opportunity Council will begin distribution of free 6-ride passes on Friday, July 2. Passes will be available every Friday at 1111 Cornwall Ave. from 8-9am, limited to 2 per person per month.
