LIHEAP AIR CONDITIONING ASSISTANCE

Those who have received a Low-Income Home and Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) benefit from Opportunity Council since October 1, 2024, may be eligible to receive an air conditioning (A/C) unit to help cool their home this summer.

LIHEAP A/C assistance is available until July 31, 2025, or while supplies last. This is a once in seven years benefit.

DROP-IN CHILDCARE

New service for parents and guardians coming soon

Coming soon: Peace Centers/Childcare Spaces won a Healthy Children's Fund award to make <u>drop-in childcare care available</u> to guardians in Whatcom County. Licensed childcare providers throughout the county will set aside to dedicated spaces daily for drop-in care and create an online system that makes it easy for guardians to find and request care.
