988 SUICIDE & CRISIS LIFELINE

Our country has entered a new era of more equitable and accessible crisis services, marked by the adoption of 988 as the easy to remember threedigit dialing, texting, and chat code for anyone experiencing a suicidal or mental health related crisis. As the U.S.-based universal dialing code connecting to the existing National Suicide Prevention Lifeline — a network of local crisis centers throughout the country — 988 increases the accessibility and use of life-saving interventions and resources.

The Substance Abuse & Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) has developed a <u>988</u> <u>Partner Toolkit</u> to help service providers and community partners speak with one voice to ensure there is a clear understanding about what 988 is and how it works.
