Great news! USDA approved Washington's Summer and Children Under 6 P-EBT plans, and DSHS plans to issue benefits soon. Since federal rules have changed, the P-EBT Summer and Children Under 6 plans will assist different groups of children separately. Qualifications for each program can be found at <u>dshs.wa.gov/pebt</u>.
