

Whatcom Transportation Authority (WTA) will provide free rides on all bus trips within Whatcom County from August 10 through August 19, 2023. Free Fare Days is an opportunity for both regular riders and newcomers to experience the ease and efficiency of WTA's bus services at no cost.

WTA's Free Fare Days will once again coincide with the <u>Northwest</u> <u>Washington Fair</u>, offering fairgoers the opportunity to hop on the bus to Lynden and enjoy the festivities without the added cost of gas and parking.

In addition to free rides on fixed route buses, all rides are free on paratransit, and on WTA's Lynden Hop (This does not include Route 80X service to Mount Vernon.)
