BASIC FOOD UPDATES

DSHS recently announced a few important updates to the Basic Food program (SNAP/EBT) that may affect EBT customers:

- Beginning 8/22, cash and food benefits older than 274 days will be automatically removed from EBT accounts. Read more.
- Effective 8/1, EBT accounts will be suspended for single-person households incarcerated for 30 days or more. This protects benefits from misuse, and ensures benefits are available within 48 hours of the time a person reports their release. Read more.
- P-EBT benefits were issued in late July to children under 6 who already have a P-EBT card. Approval letters are currently being sent to newly eligible children under 6 who do not have a card yet, and P-EBT cards should arrive shortly after. DSHS expects all letters and cards for children under 6 to be issued by 8/23. If a child under 6 has not received their P-EBT card by 9/3, call the P-EBT line at 833-518-0282. Read more.
