## **BROADBAND BENEFITS FOR BACK TO SCHOOL**

Students are heading back to school, and regardless of where students are learning, they need internet access. Households that have a student who received free and reduced school lunch or breakfast benefits during the last school year, as well as students who received a Pell Grant this year may be eligible for a discount of up to \$50 per month on their broadband service, or up to \$75 per month if they live on qualifying Tribal lands. # **BACK ON THE ROAD:**

New Ruling Lifts Many Suspended Drivers Licenses

The Department of Licensing (DOL) can no longer suspend driver's licenses because a driver failed to pay non-criminal traffic tickets and/or failed to appear at a related hearing. As the result of a recent court ruling, the DOL must reinstate these suspended licenses, meaning they will no longer be suspended. The court also prohibited DOL from automatically suspending a driver's license for unpaid traffic tickets until a new law goes into effect in January 2023.
