EARLY HEAD START AND PRESCHOOL

Though the school year is underway, it is not too late for families to enroll in preschool and early learning opportunities. <u>Opportunity Council is enrolling</u> now for the preschool program year and for Early Head Start. All families are welcome, and there is no charge to participate in these programs.

- Early Head Start: Program consists of weekly home visits that focus on developmentally appropriate play, establishing a family goal, and two socialization experiences per month. Prenatal age 3.
- **Preschool:** Classes offered 4 days/week including quarterly home visits and school conferences to establish child and family goals. Ages 3-5.
