### **IMMIGRANT RELIEF FUND**

This week the Washington COVID-19 Immigrant Relief Fund began accepting applications. This new fund will distribute \$1,000 per person (up to \$3,000 per household) to Washington residents who are ineligible for federal stimulus funds or unemployment benefits because of immigration status.

To apply, individuals must be:

- A Washington state resident
- At least 18 years of age
- Significantly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic (such as losing employment, being diagnosed with COVID-19, having to care for a family member diagnosed with COVID-19)
- And ineligible for the federal stimulus check and/or unemployment compensation because of their immigration status

Applications are available online at <u>immigrantreliefwa.org</u> from 10/21 - 12/6. Eligible applicants may also apply over the phone at 1-844-724-3737, M-F from 9 AM — 9 PM, or by mail.
