ENERGY AWARENESS MONTH

October is National Energy Awareness Month: a time to promote sustainability, conservation, energy efficiency, and reflection on energy consumption in our homes and our communities.

Almost one-third of U.S. households have reported difficulty paying energy bills or adequately heating and cooling their homes, and over 20% of households have reported reducing or forgoing necessities such as food and medicine to pay an energy bill.

Opportunity Council has programs to help alleviate these costs and reduce both the environmental and economic impact of energy use in our community:

Energy Assistance: assistance for home heating and energy costs. Scheduling begins 11/7, 9 AM -2 PM online, or by phone: 360-255-2192. See flyer for additional details. Income limits have changed, making even more households eligible for assistance. Additionally, utility shut-offs and late fees are postponed for all water, gas, and electric utilities through 12/31 due to governor order.

<u>Weatherization:</u> assistance to improve energy efficiency, durability, indoor air quality and health & safety in homes. Call (360) 734-5121 option 5

<u>Conservation Education:</u> energy assessments and workshops to identify ways to save on energy bills, conserve energy and water, and improve health and safety in homes. Call (360) 734-5121 option 5
