YOUTH HOMELESSNESS MONTH

Youth homelessness is a growing crisis in our nation, which is why November has been named National Youth Homelessness Awareness Month. Here in Whatcom County, the 2020 Point-in-Time Census of Homeless Residents counted 41 unaccompanied youth households between ages 13-24 (read the full report here). Locally, Northwest Youth Services is focused on serving this population, providing a wide range of services and programs, including:

EMERGENCY SHELTER & HOUSING PROGRAMS

<u>The PAD:</u> emergency housing for ages 13-17. 24-hr hotline: 360-393-0116 <u>HUSLY:</u> temporary shelter for ages 18-24

<u>Transitional & Permanent Housing Programs:</u> youth can call 360-734-9862 ext. 135, Mon, Tue, Thu, Fri, 9am - 3 pm to start the process

BASIC NEEDS & SUPPORT SERVICES

<u>The Ground Floor</u>: open Mon - Fri, 9am - 4pm at 2500 E St. to provide food, showers, laundry, basic needs & survival resources, resting rooms, and more <u>Queer Youth Project</u>: support and advocacy for LGBTQ+ youth <u>Behavioral Health Team</u>: new program with a goal to enhance and expand mental health and treatment services to youth experiencing homelessness <u>Teen Court</u>: a school-based diversion program that aims to offer youth an alternative to juvenile detention
