THE DIGITAL DIVIDE

COVID-19 has highlighted many inequities facing low income individuals and families. Among them, access to reliable internet has surfaced as a major area of concern now that many people need to work from home, schools have moved online, and many healthcare and other services are now virtual.

Currently, Washington State is working to identify gaps in high-speed internet service to work towards universal broadband access in WA by 2024. Please help them accomplish this goal by taking this 1minute survey.

Locally, Comcast is expanding access to its <u>Internet Essentials</u> program by providing 2 months of free service to new customers, and revising eligibility criteria so more households can qualify.

COUNTED THIS YEAR



The <u>Service-Based Enumeration</u> count of people who are unhoused is scheduled for 9/22– 24. There are concerns that not all organizations who work with people who are unhoused have been contacted, so there is a state-wide effort to reach out to networks to see who has or has not been approached by the Census Bureau. If your organization works with people who are unhoused, please take a moment to fill out <u>this survey</u> by <u>September 1st</u>. The results will be shared with the Census Bureau to aid in their efforts for a complete count.
