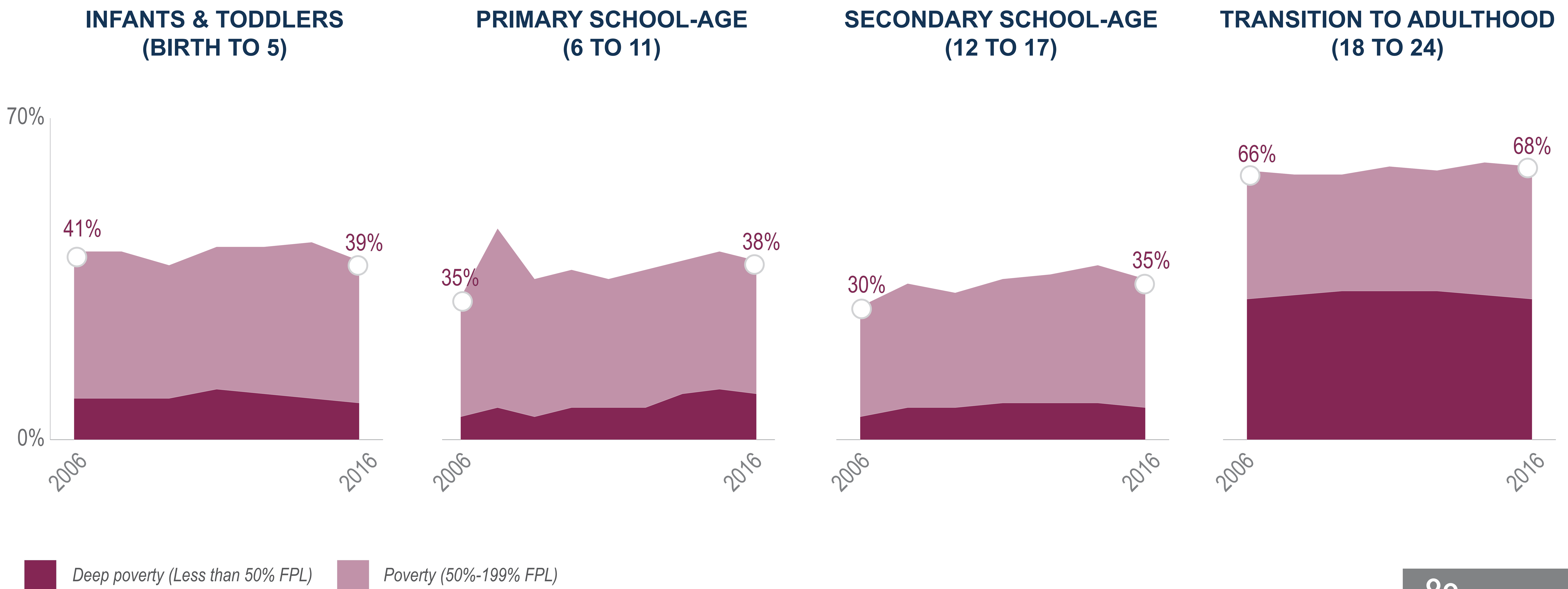


HOW HAS CHILD POVERTY CHANGED IN WHATCOM?

Poverty is highest among children as they transition to adulthood (18 to 24), and over one in three infants, toddlers, and primary school-age children experience poverty. Poverty rates for children of all ages remain near or above pre-recession levels.
