Resource Database Technology

- Engaging a tech consultant
 - Need to engage a consultant with tech expertise to help us define and finetune what we are trying to accomplish, and what our options are
 - o Eric from Vinculo has been providing a similar function for NS ACH
- <u>Pierce County Help Me Grow Implementation Plan</u> may provide some insight for their process in developing a resource referral platform
 - Especially key to look into staffing costs: one of the largest expenses that will need to be communicated to stakeholders

Funding Needs Brainstorm

- What are our immediate funding needs? Future funding needs?
 - Tech Consult
 - o Software for a short-term upgrade to OC database
 - o Human Design Assessment
 - Staffing Capacity increases to support the database update.
 - Representative Governance Structure for a Community Utility and a specific entity to do the curation/management work.
 - o Quality Improvement/Assessment and Eval
 - Equity Focus
 - Marketing/Promotion
- Where are our potential funding sources?
 - WAHA transferred funds to Chuckanut Health Foundation. About \$100K to promote access to services. Initial proposal to Health at CHF.
 - WCHD RFP: Navigation System dollars for Families raising children to 8. Expanding the SEAs Navigation System.
 - o Federal COVID support dollars coming to the County.
