- The Equity Advisor Group has been working to develop a couple of new bill assistance programs.
- Starting October 1st: Bill Discount Rate discount on your bill from 5-45% depending on level of need and household income. This is a new program. Changes to PSE Help: no documentation requirements, no need for SSN or ID.

- Application is only available in English, so hopefully this will change soon.

Lifeline Connections

- Behavioral health agency in Bellingham, for all of Whatcom.
- Outpatient mental health program just cleared waitlist, open for enrollment, and offering an additional prescriber.
- Anyone seeking affordable mental health services, call Lifeline.
- PACT team: serves people with serious mental illness: someone who's tried other services, but nothing's working.
- Offers peer support, counseling, prescribing, medication support, case management, and access to other services like employment and education.
- Lifeline can take multiple sources of insurance, not just Medicaid.
- Housing program can help people find housing, but Lifeline does not have housing.

Contact Counseling Recovery Services

- Private substance use disorder facility. Can provide drug and alcohol counseling, assessments, intervention, referral to inpatient treatment, sober living and outpatient treatment to both youth and adults
- Expanding and hiring more clinicians, as well as moving towards accepting Medicaid. Currently only taking private insurance.
- 12-step based care, with 41 sober living beds available. Currently no pets or family members allowed except for visits.
